

Capturing Summer supply list

-notebook, pencil
-printer paper about 2 sheets
-parchment paper 10inx30in minimum
** batik cotton, a piece 11in wide by 30in should give you a finished hanging about 8in by 24in The extra fabric allows for turnings.

-fusible web, Misty Fuse or another type equally fine, enough to cover your work twice. It does not need to have a paper backing.

-Fabric pieces for the chosen flowers, to contrast with the background, different parts of a fat quarter batik cotton work well

-paper scissors

-fabric scissors or cutter and mat

-Sewing machine

-machine needles size 80

-darning foot [quilting foot] for free motion machine embroidery

-embroidery hoop*

-sewing machine threads for the flowers in darker and lighter colours than the actual flower fabric and greens for the stalks and leaves

-Angelina fibres only if you have a few. I will bring my threads bits which you might prefer to use.

** I will send some swatches of batik cottons which would be suitable to use as backgrounds.

I will bring to the workshop the very fine organza needed for the workshop. The fee will be \$3.00 per person.

*The hoop is to be used when you free motion machine embroider the flowers. I find that good quality wooden hoops, about 8in. diameter, from Europe are the best.

I can supply some if needed.
