

## **Mock Hand Appliqué Class**

Mock hand appliqué is a method of machine work that is very hard to tell from actual hand appliqué. There is no raw edge or fusible material and it goes much faster than handwork. We'll explore various shapes and curves and end up with a large traditional basket block suitable for a quilt or pillow top. Once the technique is mastered, virtually all appliqué designs can be completed with an heirloom quality level of finish by machine.

## **Supply List**

Pattern \$6.00

Best machine in good working order (preferably with blanket stitch, blind hem stitch or zig-zag) Bring your book.

Open toe foot

Size 70 needle (new)

Sew-Art or YLI nylon thread .004

Light weight bobbin thread to match background fabric 60 wt. or Aurifil 50 wt

Basic sewing supplies including paper scissors, small pointed scissors, pins,

Spray mister and washcloth

Freezer paper

Non-permanent glue stick (water soluble) i.e. CVS brand, UHU, Elmer's, Ross

18" block of light colored fabric for background

Small pieces of assorted solid or hand-dyed fabric including green, blue and flower colors, washed and ironed

12"+ square of basket fabric

Purple or blue wash out pen and fine point Sharpie pen
