When I accepted to chair this year's show I did not realize how involved I would become in this project centered in Nairobi, Kenya. I have just returned from two weeks working with a group of nine women from the Kibera slum, the largest in Africa. The poverty is jarring and heartbreaking but these women have been working months with no salary sewing (on treadle machines) fabric baskets which we have brought back to sell. The women three of us taught last August took a leap of faith and are counting on us to help them improve their lives and those of their many children. Seeing their sewing skills improve, their growth as a group, their creativity and pride in their work was so wonderful. We're three quilters who now must learn to set up a non-profit, design a webpage, make connections and find markets here and in Kenya.
