Basic tools:

1. *A small rotary cutter with a sharp blade 18 mm
2. Cutting mat
3. Iron and board
4. Straight pins (flower heads preferable, only if you have them)
5. *Xacto knife, or paper scissors if you prefer
6. Scotch magic tape
7. Ballpoint pen
8. Painters tape
9. Extension cord

*will be available for sale in class if you don't have them

Fabrics:

1. 11 x 17" black cotton fabric.
2. Bring a good variety of fabrics

What kind of fabrics?

Bring a variety of those wonderful Commercial **MOTTLED BATIKS** or **hand dyes** with **multi colors/multi-values in one piece**. The "watercolor" **spotchy** type of multi value fabric (you know the ones, they look like someone used it to wipe up spills or clean their brushes. Or bring hand dyes if there is **strong enough contrast of very lights and very darks throughout the piece and variety of values (Darks to lights) in one piece**. If you have your own hand dyes, even better. **The more multiple values, from very dark to very light, there are in one piece of fabric the better.** **Don't think natural skin tones, think outside the box, the more colors the better!**

Please bring a good selection for choice, those suitcases on wheels are a great invention!
