

## **“Two Dimensional Drawings like Flowers, Fish, Bugs and Leaves Divided into Irregular Polygons”**

Description:

- Create or copy a simple design and learn to divide it into irregular polygons.
- Draw and cut individual templates, covering them with fabrics and sewing them together or use them as patterns for machine sewing.
- Make a small collage out of fabric and/or paper scraps to be used as a model (maquette) for a quilt project. Learn how to use grids to enlarge the maquette to sewable size.

Supply List:

Sewing needles, pins, thimble, neutral and main color matching threads, scissors for both paper and fabric, glue stick or glue, note/sketch paper, pencil, eraser, thick paper for templates like drawing paper, ruler or protractor, ball point pen, waterproof felt tipped pen to draw on plastic, scotch tape, transparent plastic folder, about 10 colored pages from magazines or calendars, etc.

Optional: Pictures of flowers, fish, bugs, butterflies, leaves, etc.

Fabric: Leftovers of any color, flower lovers with focus on natural greens, fish lovers with a lot of light blue, or neutral colors for backgrounds like several grays and beiges.
