This unique drawstring bag is made out of just 2 fat quarters. It's easy to sew and quite addictive. You can create it with two inside or outside pockets in different sizes, out of different fabrics (e.g., cotton, batiks, silks, Japanese fabrics), and for different occasions (e.g., Halloween Trick or Treat bag, gift bags for Christmas, birthdays or baby showers).

Chances are good that you'll be able to make more than one pouch during the class, so feel free to bring several fat quarters; you can also bring yardage and start/make a bigger second bag.

Supply List for one bag:

1 fat quarter of main fabric

1 fat quarter of lining fabric

2 yards of ribbon or 1/8" diameter cord for drawstrings

Optional: 2 beads with large hole to use at end of drawstring

Matching or neutral/gray thread for sewing, scissors, 1 small safety pin, That Purple Thang

Sewing machine, rotary mat, rotary cutter, ruler, **extension cord**

Iron and ironing board to share
