

Winter Free Workshop – February 9, 2019

Following the process of Helen Howes:

<http://www.helenhowestextiles.co.uk/kitsandpatterns/treetutorial.html>, we will insert varied widths of tree branch fabrics into a contrasting background. Machine piecing will result in a unique tree block; if you make more, you can have a forest!

Materials List:

For each tree block, bring:

12" or 15" square background fabric (or a 12" x 15" rectangle)

several long strips of tree branch fabric, 1" and 1.5" wide (any contrasting solid or print)

It would be helpful to have a large square ruler or piece of cardboard, for transporting the work to the sewing machine and for keeping the pieces in order. Cutting mat can be used for this purpose if it's not too large

Also bring:

Sewing Machine and basic sewing kit

Rotary cutter with a new blade

12" or 20" ruler

Cutting Mat at least 16 X 24"

Iron and iron pad (helpful, but not necessary – we can share)
