

## Sandra Lee Chandler – Bomber Jacket Supply List

Supplies:

- Pattern Simplicity D0759 or 8418 (Please use your measurements NOT the sizes on the pattern) for fabric requirements
- Quilt (refer to the pattern and the size you will be creating for yardage)
- Thread
- Zipper (refer to the pattern for size)
- Band ribbing (refer to the pattern)
- I used denim for the sleeves, but you can use anything you wish

Before the workshop, check the pattern's fit by making a sample jacket with sleeves, using paper or muslin.

(Front & back of jacket: A quilt or other suitable piece of upcycled material that measures at least 36" x 45". Vintage "<u>cutter quilts</u>" can often be found for cheap on sites like Ebay. These are quilts have been deemed too worn for use on beds, but often have plenty of salvageable (and beautiful)

Sleeves: Denim or fabric for the sleeves (7/8 yards) of 45" wide fabric or old jeans which you will deconstruct)
